**1. Consideration and possible action: Adoption of an Order Canvassing the Returns and Declaring the Results of a General City Officers' Election**

City Manager Joe Dickson read the vote totals for the General City Officers' Election. There were 1,383 votes cast and the candidates received the following votes:

<b>COUNCIL, PLACE 2</b>		
Wanda Wagner	684 early votes	1,097 total votes

<b>COUNCIL, PLACE 3</b>		
Jeff Tambrella	696 early votes	1,119 total votes

Motion by Councilmember Abney, seconded by Councilmember Tambrella to adopt the Order Canvassing the Returns and Declaring the Results of a General City Officers' Election. The motion passed the roll call vote unanimously.

**2. Consideration and possible action: Adoption of an Order Canvassing the Returns and Declaring the Results of a Special Election**

City Manager Joe Dickson read the vote totals for the Special Bond Election. There were 1,383 votes cast and Proposition 1 received the following votes:

FOR	398 early votes	619 total votes
AGAINST	421 early votes	745 total votes
