

The Court may issue an arrest warrant when:

- You fail to appear
- You fail to comply with an Order of the Court
- You fail to make scheduled payments

### **Failure to Appear**

If you fail to appear on or before the due date on your citation, a violation for failure to appear or violate promise to appear may be filed against you. In addition the Court may:

- Issue a warrant for your arrest
- Add additional fees per violation
- Place a hold on your Driver's License Renewal
- Place a hold on your Vehicle Registration Renewal

### **Failure to comply with an Order of the Court**

If you have appeared and have agreed to pay, make scheduled payments on a payment plan, or any other order of the Court, you must comply with those orders as specified by the Judge or a warrant may be issued for your arrest.

**Arrest warrants** are issued for defendants who received a citation and/or a court date and failed to appear in Court when scheduled or failed to make arrangements on citation.

If you have a regular arrest warrant, your options are:

- Pay in full.
- Post a cash bond in the full amount of your warrants to receive a new court date.
- You may turn yourself in at the Santa Fe Police Department located at 3650 FM 646 N, Santa Fe, TX 77510.
- Contact the City Marshal, Robert Wood, at 713-569-5428 to make other arrangements.

**Capias Pro-Fine warrants** are issued on defendants who received a citation, have been found guilty by the Court, and failed to comply with orders of the Court.

If you have a Capias Pro-Fine warrant, your options are:

- Pay in full.
- You may turn yourself in at the Santa Fe Police Department located at 3650 FM 646 N, Santa Fe, TX 77510.

If you have warrants, you are subject to arrest at any time. The City Marshal is actively searching for you. To avoid arrest, you must immediately resolve this matter by contacting the Santa Fe Municipal Court at 409-925-3255 or City Marshal at 713-569-5428.
