NOTES OF SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING :

Heritage Festival - in Conjunction with the 35th City Anniversary/Birthday – It was noted that all organizations should be on board with the meetings (Rotary, Chamber of Commerce, Education Foundation) so more of the community would be involved of the event – which is being held Saturday, November 9th 2013. Letters were sent out to the community from the Mayor to notify different organizations, churches, businesses about the “Kick-off” to the Event. Not as many attended as expected. Lynn Trahan explained how money was raised by each organization that is involved with the Heritage Festival; (HIS Ministries, Lions Club, Historical Foundation, Friends of the Library, Thelma Webber Center - Seniors), by each having a booth – all proceeds are put into one “pot” and then split 5 ways.

Shirts – The City would supply enough shirts for volunteers/workers – per Diana – it would not be profitable to have a large quantity of t-shirts. The logo was discussed as having the City of Santa Fe logo or the Heritage Logo (red, white & blue). It was also discussed with advertisement on the shirt to maybe fund any shirts that are purchased.
